So.....how good do you want to be?

The chances are that you may not have been aware that the 52<sup>nd</sup> ISSF World Championships took place in Seoul from 31<sup>st</sup> August to 15<sup>th</sup> September. To bring it down to a local level which we can more easily relate to, Surrey fielded no less than 5 members of the British team. Surbiton's very own David Goodfellow again attended in his role as Jury member.

We might well think that the scores shot by the top people are way out of reach, but they all started at clubs much like ours and many continue to do so. Granted there are always some countries who take their "system" to a professional level, but this is not always an advantage. Kenny Parr, who shoots at Croydon, finished in 8<sup>th</sup> place in the men's prone event. Unfortunately this discipline has recently been dropped from the Olympic programme, but has been replaced by others which are intended to broaden the interest and appeal of the sport to the media.

The British women had a successful championship with Seonaid McIntosh becoming 50m Prone Rifle Women's World Champion and then with her sister, Jen and Zoe Bruce, claiming the team bronze. Seonaid also finished 4<sup>th</sup> in the 50m 3 Positions Women's Rifle, thereby winning a quota place for the Tokyo 2020 Olympics.
